nce the TV industry attended the last "normal" MIPCOM in 2019, the U.S. has a new president, the U.K. has a new monarch, Italy has a new "temporary" government, the Russians are being banned in many parts of the world for their invasion of Ukraine, the Philippines went back to the future with another Marcos as president, Netflix is no longer the only streaming game in town, and exhibitors at MIPCOM are playing musical chairs with their stands, while the "bunker" (P-1, the basement floor of the Palais) has been reopened.

Other than that, everything else is staying the same, or at least so it seemed yesterday, on MIPCOM CANNES' first day. Let's see what



today brings.

Before walking through the corridors, we caught up with Chevonne O'Shaughnessy, president of ACI, to hear about her expectations for this market. "The TV channels were buying a lot prior to COVID," she said, "and now that VoD has grown exponentially, it's a different way (Continued on Page 4)

Travel Ban Over Russia To Help A Needed AFM

IPCOM has always been a thorn in the AFM's side since it tends to begin a few days after the end of the Cannes market. This year, the AFM opens its doors in Santa Monica, California on November 1.

Many times in years past, buyers would reach the AFM with their whole budget for the year already depleted. They'd only be able to acquire any so-called "gems" they discovered at the mart by requesting extra money or by taking funds from next year's budgets.

However, the situation could be different this year, at least for Asian buyers, and this is because, since the Russian invasion of Ukraine, the air space over Russia is closed to all European airlines for flights to and from Asia, the shortest route between the two regions. Asian airlines aren't actually banned from the space, but many Asian carriers are avoiding the Russian air space for safety reasons.



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

The death of linear TV has been somewhat exaggerated. And it took an actual death — that of Queen Elizabeth II — to prove it, with linear TV ratings going up throughout the coverage of her death and her state funeral.



This consciousness was trigged by the September 8 death of the 96-year-old queen, the beloved British monarch who reigned for 70 years, from 1952 to 2022.

Following her death, American TV audiences flocked, once again, to linear TV channels on both cable and broadcast TV. (Netflix's *The Crown* also saw a surge in viewership.)

Now that Trump is out of the White House, the greater American monarchical inclination has resurfaced and the ratings were there to prove it. After the U.S. TV networks announced that the queen had died, the conservative FOX News topped the ratings with 2.28 million viewers, but the liberal CNN and MSNBC did just as well with 1.8 million for CNN, and 1.19 million for MSNBC. And the U.S.

broadcast networks' ratings cumulatively topped 17 million viewers for the main three nightly news programs on ABC, CBS, and NBC.

For most of the 11 straight days of mourning and the proclamation of King Charles III as Britain's newest monarch, the national broadcast evening news shows in the U.S. began their coverage with the latest reports from the U.K. Even lo-

cal U.S. stations' news shows flew their anchors to London, where it seemed that almost everybody was dressed in black. Britain came to a virtual standstill. Even football (soccer) matches were suspended (but not cricket or rugby).

While the U.S. cable news channels offered wall-towall coverage, the broadcast networks moved their entire news and current affairs operations to the U.K. ABC News' David Muir anchored World News Tonight from London. Good Morning America featured extensive coverage from the U.K. This Week with George Stephanopoulos also broadcast from London. Similarly, Norah O'Donnell anchored CBS Evening News from London. Presumably, the need to get "personalized" views from the U.K. stemmed from the assumption that the American public would find the accents of U.K. stringers difficult to understand, and would tune out, despite the curiosity attached to the events. However, the Americans (both in broadcast and print) weren't as accurate as their British counterparts. One of many errors included calling the U.K. flag the "Union Jack" when it was shown as mounted on buildings, instead of simply calling it the "Union flag." The "Union Jack" is exclusively flown on ships.

America has always been ambivalent about the monarchy in general, and has treated various members of the British royal family like Hollywood stars: good to fill the gossip pages.

That changed

during the Trump

reign in 2017, when, led by

their president, some Ameri-

cans started openly admiring

tsarists like Russia's Vladimir

Putin and China's dynastic Xi

Jinping. Trump would even

write "beautiful letters" to

North Korea's king-like dicta-

tor Kim Jong-un, and started

wondering why he couldn't be

just like him, with a U.S. Con-

gress that would simply rub-



ber-stamp his decisions.

It is also possible that the reason for the high TV ratings was because Americans were curious about the queen. After all, as U.K. filmmaker Hanif Kureishi (*My Beautiful Laundrette*) once said, the British monarchy is soon destined to become just as symbolic as the one in The Netherlands. Therefore, many Americans wanted to witness what they assume might be this century's last grandiose royal funeral.

Presumably, a peak for linear TV will be recorded again during King Charles' actual coronation ceremony in a few months.

of making money. Now I discuss my films that will excel on my [streaming] platforms."

When asked if she'd be taking brand-new content (never before shown anywhere) with her to the market, she answered in the affirmative. "Yes! I just added *It's Christmas Again* to my catalog, a brand-new movie reminding us of other ways to spend Christmas."

She continued: "We will be filming from a book series, *Finding Love in Sisters*, a Latin American story about sisters dealing with their own journey while mourning the death of their mother. In addition, we added Nigerian films to our list of films, such as *Wedding Party*."

Will the fact that Asians cannot fly over Russian air space reduce the number of Asian buyers? "Yes, but unfortunately Asian buyers do not take romatic drama, they mainly like action films," she said.

The Detroit-born Lico is a 45-plus year veteran who has dealt with all aspects of programming, research, scheduling, sales, marketing, production and talent during his years in the entertainment business.

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Streaming To Become the Next Box Office

n the strength of my *My* 2¢ track record, I'm venturing to make a few predictions, most notably that Comcast will not be acquiring Warner Bros. Discovery. It's simply too costly if one adds all the liabilities (\$53 billion) and the cost of the stock (\$31.34 billion and a possible premium). Plus, it's not needed if Comcast is simply looking to get its hands on its streaming platform, HBO Max.

I also predict that the streaming service war will end soon - before they all cannibalize each other. After

all, streaming will become like cinema releases. The new box office will be the amount of TVoDs, or number of subscribers driven by a particular movie or TV series. It's not like studios are constantly buying and selling each other based on their box office results, right?

In effect, the U.S. will be going back to the pre-1948 "Paramount Decrees" era, when the large Hollywood studios controlled the motion picture industry through their ownership of film distribution and exhibition.

Today, streaming constitutes a form of distribution that replaces or replicates theatrical distribution, as was the case prior to 1948. Now, it's

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called "platform exclusivity."

Plus, the studios are not expected to be interested in creating semi-monopolies with the risk of, once again, triggering government actions that could result not only in having to divest themselves of their streaming platforms, but also of their broadcast TV networks.

The world would be happy to see the studios fragmented. Producers would be in the front row looking for more revenues. Politicians would be waiting for some big, flamboyant issue to tackle. And Wall Street would already be savoring its huge fees.

Getting the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), and/or the E.U. antitrust Commission (DG Competition) after the U.S. studios for "restraint of trade" could be another brick falling on the head of streamers (in addition to the current financial burden).

As mentioned above, there is a 1948 precedent for that, the "Paramount Decrees" (so called because it was the largest of the Hollywood studios). Here's the story: In 1938, the DOJ filed a lawsuit alleging that eight major studios had conspired to control the motion picture industry through their ownership of film distribution and exhibition. The case reached the U.S. Supreme Court in 1948, which forced all of the studios to divest themselves of their movie theater chains. The Court also outlawed various motion picture distribution practices, including exclusive film licenses for specific geographic areas.

In 2020, believing the antitrust restriction was no longer necessary, as the old model could never be recreated in contemporary settings, the DOJ issued a "sunsetting" (phasing out) notice.

However, according to some legal experts, the "restraint of trade" principle is now exercised through the "platform exclusivity" that the U.S. studios require for their own "exhibitions," which take the form of subscription television, otherwise called "streaming," SVoD (or simply on-demand), and, generically, OTT.

This year is a special MIPCOM for FilmRise, as well. "While in the past years, buyers could find FilmRise as sponsors of the Buyers Lounge, we [now] are in a new location and stand, the Riviera Hall R7.N9," said Emilia Nuccio, Film-Rise's VP, International Content Sales, who added: "We encourage buyers to stop by and get to know us even if they don't have any appointments."

Nuccio continued, "Historically, MIPCOM hasbeen the most attended of the two televisionrelated Cannes markets, and with the pandemic behind us, the desire to be in person, and it being the last big global market of the year, MIPCOM should be very productive and exciting."

As for new content brought to the market, Nuccio explained: "While FilmRise is known for its digital AVoD and FAST Channels content, we [have] two 2 new film releases at MIPCOM: *MVP*, a movie that has been released theatrically, and *A Christmas Karen*. These films are in addition to the digital rights to the popular series *Cheaters*, a robust crime slate, and digital native series like *Preston and Brianna*, that appeal to a younger audience."

And, as far as the territories covered, Nuccio pointed out that "the FilmRise brand is expanding internationally as we make our way to Eastern Europe, MENA and Africa."

This means that in order to reach Europe for MIPCOM, Asian buyers will have to travel longer hours, and flights will likely be more ex-pensive. This, however, should help the AFM, which being on the western coast of the U.S., would not be affected by the Russian air space ban.

This couldn't have happened at a more propitious time because this edition of the AFM is supremely important.

Ryan Friscia, Neon's EVP of Finance & Business Development, will "be sourcing content at AFM, looking for quality product only," he said. "I expect a low turnout from Asia because of their COVID travel restrictions."

Chevonne O'Shaughnessy, president of ACI, disagreed, noting that she thinks that the Russian air space debacle will increase the number of Asian buyers at the AFM.

As far as the future of the AFM, O'Shaughnessy expressed the view that the "market can survive by bringing in the people who are focusing on FAST channels or the people who are doing the new technology channels. Or maybe by bringing VoD demanded platforms."

For Friscia, "the market has really rebounded," as has "the theatrical business," he said. "The idea that [the theatrical business] is going away is completely false."

Irv Holender, chairman of Multicom, is renting the "same AFM room we had for years." He expects a great market with buyers who'll be drawn to his vast catalog of movies in various languages.

Lico's Forensic Files In Search of a New Home

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In addition to Forensic Files, he has brought a number of hits to television, including Inside The Actors Studio, Monster Quest, Intersections, House of Babies, 7 Days Left, Secret Lives of Women, and dozens more.

So why is Lico retiring? And what's going to happen to his beloved Forensic Files? Lico explained: "As I approach 70, the big question was not, 'when am I going to retire?' but if. Then came a diverticulosis attack, which made me lose 2/3 of my blood. Spending nearly a week groggy in the hospital, three thoughts came to mind: What's gonna happen to me? What's gonna happen to my family? And what about Forensic Files? If something happened to me, what about the show? I am not inflating my job description when I say I do pretty much everything but produce the show. I conceived it, distribute it, handle the operations, materials, and PR, and am producing my second tribute to the program. So the time to retire came through loud and clear... Now. And what better time and place to announce than at MIPCOM? For the first time in years, the market is crowded and hugs abound. All my current clients and many of my friends are here."

Reminiscing about past achievements, Lico reminded us that he started in the business in 1977 at age 22, having been recruited fresh out of Syracuse University by SFM Media's Stan Moger to sell the new *Mickey Mouse Club* show. "I traveled to 45 states and cities big and small," he said. "In one city, I had to look for the TV tower to find the station. Then I had a chance to chase my dream and co-host the daytime TV show, *A New Day*. It did great. It was broadcast in syndication in over 75 percent of the U.S. Then I got fired."

In 1980, Lico went to work at media rep Katz as a programmer, and three years later landed at the New York office of Embassy. The company was bought by Coca Cola and merged with Columbia. It was then sold to Sony.

CABLEready was born in 1992, because, as he explained, "As my role at Columbia reduced, I set out on my own with a \$50,000 purse, but also a Greenwich, Connecticut mortgage and two boys under five."

He continued: "We were around for 21 years... but successful for only about 18 of them. When our two biggest revenue-generating productions were cancelled, CABLEready went into a nosedive. But I was able to keep my relationship with Medstar Television, which produced the original 400 episodes of Forensic Files, and with CNN Productions, the new production house for the last few years and at least the next couple. It's a program with a stronger future than its past. It just needs someone bigger to handle things... a company with a few departments and specialties. That's the other reason for the announcement at MIPCOM ... to search for the next distributor since FilmRise just has the VoD rights for the U.S. and a number of countries."

Road To MIP Cancun: What To Expect

s of the middle of September, 90 companies had already signed on to exhibit at MIP Cancun, some with multiple tables. And over 100 buying companies from 22 countries were set to attend, mostly from the U.S. (22 buyers), Brazil (19 buyers), Argentina and Mexico (each with 12 buyers).

On the sales side the largest contingents will arrive from France and the U.S., with 21 companies each, followed by the U.K. (with eight) and Turkey (with seven). A total of 600 delegates have already confirmed their attendance at the 9th edition of the LATAM market, which will return to the Moon Palace Resort on November 13–16.

The organizers are also expecting plenty of co-production meetings and conferences. One that shouldn't be missed is with Brazilianborn Cecilia Mendonca (pictured below), head of Content Development for The Walt Disney



Company (based in Buenos Aires), and Tiago Mello, executive producer and partner at Boutique Filmes (based in Sao Paulo, Brazil). It'll be moderated by *VideoAge*'s Dom Serafini. The session will be held in the Main Auditorium on November 14, the market's second day, from 5:30 p.m. to 6 p.m., followed by 15 minutes of meeting with the speakers. The theme of the talk will be "Spotlight on Brazil: A View to Its Voices, Content, and Evolution of the Sector."

For this LATAM market, *VideoAge* will be publishing its traditional November Edition, which will receive bonus distribution in Cancun, featuring (among other articles) a preview of the mart, while a review of the event will appear in *VideoAge*'s December edition, which will be bound for the ATF in Singapore.


